

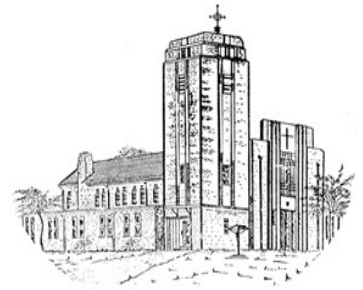

EUCCHARISTIC ADORATION

Prayer of Adoration to the Blessed Sacrament.
